

About the Production Team...

Linda Marley Smith (Director/Set Design) Linda is secretary of the Board of Peninsula Community Theatre. She has directed many plays, including *The Lion in Winter, Inherit the Wind, A Few Good Men,* and *The Diary of Anne Frank*. She has also thoroughly enjoyed acting and singing on the PCT stage in such productions as *Les Misérables, Into the Woods, Death of a Salesman,* and *The Hallelujah Girls*. She spends her retirement on theatrical and church projects, traveling, tending to her garden, and serving as a questionable example to her beloved granddaughters Celie and Eleanor.

Sheri Beyrau (Stage Manager) is glad to be back before live audiences with *Almost, Maine* after *Vanya* and *Sonia* and *Masha* and *Spike*. She has worked in many local theatres across Hampton Roads since the early 90s and currently serves on the board of directors at Peninsula Community Theatre.
